

## **VISITOR PARKING Near the Main Library**



**PARKING METERS** provide the most traditional, short term, close-in parking at MSU. The rates in duration of each meter are posted on each meter. **Times and schedules vary; please check the meter before you walk away.** *Malfunctioning meters are considered NO PARKING ZONES.* 

Meter Parking (West Circle Drive) 6 meters near Music Building ( 🛃 2 of 3 van accessible.)	C3
Meter Parking (West Circle Drive)	B3
Meter Parking (Union and Abbot Road)   28 meters ( 🛃 4 accessible) west side of Union.	B4
Meter Parking (off Auditorium Road)42 meters near Administration Building.	D5
Lot #62W (Red Cedar Road) Rate is 90¢ per half hour for visitors. The rate is 50¢ per half hour for commuters with valid commuter permits. <i>Cash only.</i>	D3
Museum Lot (West Circle Drive)	D6
Ramp #6 (Grand River) Employee parking* and 147 metered spots.	B5
Ramp #2 (Auditorium Road, between Computer Center and Bessey Hall) Employee parking.* No meters.	E6

Parking 2am-6am is allowed at the MSU ramps in the general employee parking spots—not the meters or the leased spaces.

\*Employee parking spaces are available to visitors 6pm through 7am Monday— Friday and all day weekends. Special rules may apply for home football games.

Main Library Lot #11 (the gated part behind the Main Library) is available to visitors 11pm through 7am Monday—Friday and after 2pm Saturday and Sunday.

( **b** 2 of 2 van accessible outside of gate; 4 of 7 van accessible inside of gate.)

Two-, four- and 24-hour visitor permits are available at the Visitor Center, at the Parking Office, or at the 24-hour Police Service Desk for a nominal fee. Restrictions apply. Visitor permits allow you to park in employee spaces only excluding meters, lease spaces, service vehicle spaces, and University vehicle spaces. **EAST LANSING PARKING (not shown)** is available in the City Center Ramp (A6) or the Colorful Ramp (A7). *East Lansing* meters are 65¢ per hour, maximum \$15 per day. Charges apply 8am-3am.
